

Academic and Social Emotional Areas of Emphasis

ELA ~ A balanced approach to language arts instruction to include accessibility to high-interest books of student choosing and instructional appropriateness, data driven instruction including goal setting and feedback, strategies to build reading stamina and phonemic awareness, opportunities for students to talk in response to texts, and intentionality in increasing rigor and developing critical thinking skills.

Math ~ Math continuum work across all grade levels to build on the knowledge of math skills and acquisition over time ~ specifically number sense and using math manipulatives and their application for problem solving strategies.

SEL ~ Capturing Kids Hearts / Dr. Tammy Pawloski (“Why Poverty Matters”) ~ Culture is ongoing and research-based studies show that school culture is a core piece in raising student achievement.

Theory of Action ~ Increasing Academic Discourse ~ “Teaching students to have meaningful conversations - purposeful talk that serves as a tool for constructing understanding with others.”

CAPTURING KIDS HEARTS

- ◇ CKH is a relationship-building approach to discipline that creates self-managing groups. Students and teachers collaborate to create social expectations via a contract that guides daily classroom interactions.
- ◇ An environment is created that emphasizes positivity through "good things" and "affirmations", which are shared daily.
- ◇ The school focuses on a social and emotional theme each month with opportunities for daily lessons and application in the classroom.
