Salaries listed are for employees on 245 day (12 mo.) contracts. For those on other annual days, the salary is obtained by multiplying the cell by one of the following factors: 220 days (11 mo.) = 0.8980; 210 days (10 1/2 mo.) = 0.8571; 205 days (10 1/4 mo.) = 0.8367; 200 days (10 mo.) = 0.8163; 190 days (9 1/2 mo.) = 0.7755; 185 days (9 1/4 mo.) = 0.7551; 180 days (9 mo.) = 0.7347.

For working retirees, the schedule above would be reduced by 5% (or 10% based on benefits election).

The schedule above includes a 2.0% cost of living increase over FY 2011-2012. Eligible employees move up a step.
