Note: Required forms must be completed as per the instructions on page 1 and injury or accident reported to the Safety Administrator by the next business day.

Emergencies and Life Threatening Injuries

1. Call 911, Upon arrival, notify EMS that this is a work related injury
2. Make contact as soon as possible with injured employee and direct employee to designated medical facility after release from emergency department for any follow up.
3. Complete required forms and report injury/incident to supervisor and safety administrator as soon as possible.
