Facts & Highlights

- ◆ Brashier Middle College Charter High School (BMC) was opened in August of 2006 with 100 Freshmen and a goal of "College for Everyone."
- ◆ Class of 2012 - 98.9% graduation rate
- ◆ 2012 graduates offered \$2.2 million in scholarships
- ◆ 95.5% of 2011 class attending two or four year colleges
- ◆ Mastery Learning with required grade of 80% or better to receive credit for classes instead of the traditional 70%
- ◆ Student to computer ratio is 1.6:1
- ◆ BMC's charter is based on the focus of dual enrollment and alignment of high school & college curriculum and the goal that students complete at least one semester of college work before they graduate.
- ◆ 2011—2012 school year
 - 77.7% of upperclassmen enrolled in college classes
 - 1934 college hours were earned
 - 98.3% pass rate with average college GPA of 3.2

- ◆ Student Led Conferences with parent and advisor
- ◆ Academic Achievement:: National Honor Society, Beta Club, Youth In Government
- ◆ Co-curricular clubs include Yearbook, BMC Newspaper
- ◆ We offer many extra-curricular activities including Student Government, Project COMMAND, Spanish Club, Volleyball, Basketball, Cross Country, Golf, Soccer, Baseball, Softball, Swimming, Ambassadors
