- ◆ Greenville Tech Charter High School (GTCHS) was opened in August 1999 with 200 students
- ◆ Class of 2015 – 100% graduation rate
- ◆ 2015 graduates offered \$6.5 million in scholarships
- ◆ 97% of Class of 2015 attends two- or four-year colleges
- ◆ Mastery Learning with required grade of 80% or better to receive credit for classes instead of the traditional 70%
- ◆ Student to computer ration is 1.2: 1
- ◆ GTCHS' charter is based on the focus of dual enrollment and alignment of high school & college curriculum and the goal that students complete at least one semester of college work before graduation
- ◆ 2014-2015 school year:
 - 70% of all students enrolled in college classes
 - 2,871 college hours earned
 - 93% pass rate with average college GPA of 3.1
