Our School Report Card was recently released by the State Department of Education. For 2013-14, <b>A. J. Whittenberg Elementary School of Engineering</b> achieved an Absolute Rating of <b>Excellent</b> and a Growth Rating of <b>Excellent</b> . The Report Cards are posted on our school district website at www.greenville.k12.sc.us.
• The Absolute Rating is based on SC Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (SCPASS) results for 2013-14 measured against target levels of performance.
• The Growth Rating indicates the progress of achievement scores for the same students from one year to the next.
• Report Cards also include our status toward meeting the Federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requirements. Our Federal ESEA grade for 2013-14 that was released several weeks ago is a "A."
The South Carolina School Report Card and ESEA grade results can be confusing because a school or school district can score well on the Report Card and not earn a high ESEA grade. Why? Absolute and Growth ratings for School Report Cards are based on student achievement at all levels of SCPASS - Not Met through Exemplary - in all tested content areas. Federal ESEA grades are based on a markedly different calculation using student achievement targets which go beyond basic proficiency in English/Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies. ESEA targets are based on average student achievement and increase each year for each student subgroup.
I encourage you to study the School and District Report Cards and to use their release as an opportunity to be more involved with your child's education and our school.
