# An Eagle's Flight to the Future: The College Search

#### Suggested questions to ask yourself about what you want in a college:

- o What size university or college do I want to attend?
- o How far from home do I want to go to school?
- o Do I prefer a city campus, a suburban location, or a small town?
- o Are there activities such as sports or clubs in which I want to participate during college? What program of study do I wish to pursue?
- Are there special services that I require (such as tutoring, readers, interpreters, etc.)?
- o Do I want to attend a single sex or co-educational school?

## Suggested questions to ask college representatives:

- o What factors do you consider when making an admissions decision?
- o What is the GPA of the average entering freshman?
- What kind of courses should I be taking in my senior year of high school?
- o Do you require the writing portion of the SAT / ACT?
- o What is the average score of new students for the SAT / ACT?
- o Are the SAT II subject tests required, and if so, which subjects are required?
- o Do I need to schedule an admissions interview?
- o When are your Open House programs?
- o Do you offer overnight visits? May I visit classes?
- What is the application deadline for admissions?
- O Do you accept Advanced Placement test credit? What are the scores needed to earn What makes you proud of your institution?
- o How do I apply for academic scholarships, and what are the deadlines for applying?

## Suggested questions about Financial Aid:

- What are the basic costs for a year (tuition, room/board, fees), and are there additional costs for out-of-state students?
- o What is the total estimated student budget for a year?
- o What types of financial aid programs are available?
- o What percentage of students receives financial aid? What is the average award?
- o What kind of need-based scholarship/grant opportunities exist?
- o What is the deadline to apply for financial aid?

## Suggested questions to ask about programs of study:

- o Do you have my major?
- o If I am not sure which major I want, are there resources available to help me choose?
- How do you assign faculty advisors to students, especially to those who are undecided about their majors?
- o What are your top programs? What unique programs does your institution offer?
- What is your job and graduate school placement rate for graduating students?
- o What is your student-to-faculty ratio and average class size?

#### Suggested questions to ask about campus life:

- o What is the total enrollment?
- o How many students live on campus? Are freshmen required to live on campus?
- o What activities are available? Sports? Arts? Sororities/Fraternities?
- o May I bring my car? How much does a parking permit cost?
- o How safe is your school? Where can I obtain statistics about crimes on your campus?
- o What are some of the causes of students being suspended or dismissed from your institution? Is there an appeals system?
