I. Scholarships & Financial Aid Information

▪ **American Leprosy Missions Scholarship**

Greenville County student planning to pursue degrees that will lead to a vocation involving international service to the poor, disenfranchised and afflicted peoples in the developing countries of the world. 2.5 GPA, high moral character as evidenced by three letters of endorsement, community service, essay. **Deadline: February 15**

▪ **Bi-Lo Urban League Scholarship**

Academic Achievement, financial need, essay, and questionnaire. **Deadline: March 17**

▪ **Greenville County Schools – Pepsi Golf Tournament Scholarship**

3.0 GPA, rank in top third of senior class, active in school and/or community activities, must not have received notification that you will receive a scholarship of \$1,000 or more by this time (Palmetto Fellows and Life Scholarships are exempt from this). Eastside HS can submit two applications. **Deadline: February 15**

▪ **Scholar Athlete Milk Mustache of the Year Scholarship (SAMMY)**

25 high school athletes who excel in academics, athletics, community service, and leadership are recognized each year. Applications can be found at <http://Sammy.bodybymilk.com>. **Deadline: March 7**

▪ **Archibald Rutledge Scholarship Competition**

Qualifications for all categories: US citizen who has attended a SC public school for the past two consecutive years. Must be used in a college or university in SC. Eastside HS can submit two entries in each category. **All applications must be submitted to Ms. Levesque in Guidance by 1/28/08.**

1. Creative Writing Competition - Original composition in the form of a sonnet, lyric, or narrative poem not to exceed one page in length.
2. Drama Competition – a short, one-act play with a performing time of twenty to forty-five minutes should be submitted.
3. Music Competition – an original composition of three to five minutes for solo or small ensemble, vocal, or instrumental in any appropriate style.
4. Visual Arts Competition – All artwork must be a completed rendered visual composition. Art is limited to two-dimensional work such as drawing and painting media, printmaking, and collage. NO three-dimensional work, photography, or computer-generated images will be accepted. All artwork must be original.
