II. Scholarships and Financial Aid

- **North Greenville University Scholarships**
  - a) **Crusader Fellows Scholarship** – Palmetto Fellows recipients are given a full scholarship to cover the cost of tuition, room, and board. Deadline: January 10
  - b) **Trustee Scholarship** – GPA 3.8 / SAT of 1300 on CR and Math or ACT composite of 29 **OR** RIC top 10%, GPA of 3.5, and SAT of 1200 on CR and math or ACT composite of 27  
Leadership, recommendation, and interview. Deadline: January 10
  - c) **Founder’s Scholarship** – Top 10% and/or have an overall GPA of 3.5 and SAT or 1200 on CR and Math or ACT of 27. Leadership & school recommendation
  - d) **President’s Scholarship** – Top 10% and GPA of 3.2 SAT of 1100 on CR and Math or ACT of 24. Leadership and recommendation
  - e) **Dean’s Scholarship** – Top 20% and GPA of 3.0, SAT of 1000 on CR and math or ACT of 21. Leadership and recommendation
  - f) **General Excellence Scholarship** – Academic achievement, SAT and/or ACT scores, character, and leadership potential. Applicants may qualify with at least two of the following criteria: SAT of 950 on CR and math **OR** ACT of 20, GPA of 3.0 or rank in top 30%.
- **James F. Byrnes Foundation Scholarship Program**  
Have one or both parents deceased, pursue a bachelor’s degree at an accredited 4-yr. college/university, satisfactory academic record, excellence in character, ability & enterprise, financial need Visit the website at [www.brynesscholars.org](http://www.brynesscholars.org) to obtain an application packet.   - b) **Lillian Simpson Scholarship** – rank in top 50% of class at end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester. Deadline: March 31 (must have completed admissions application on file with a qualifying SAT score of 480 or higher in CR and Math **OR** an ACT Math & English of 19 or higher **OR** a Greenville Tech Placement exam by 3/24/08). One senior from Eastside High will receive this award.

  - a) **LIFE Scholarship** if attending qualifying 4 yr. college in SC must meet two of these three – (1) SAT (CR & Math) 1100 or ACT Comp 24 (2) GPA 3.0 (3) RIC top 30% at end of senior year If attending qualifying 2 yr college in SC must have GPA of 3.0 at end of senior year. No application required
  - b) **Lottery Tuition Assistance** – for technical colleges. Must complete FAFSA/ cannot be combined with Life or other state scholarship
  - c) **HOPE Scholarship** – 3.0 GPA good at 4-yr colleges (1 year only) no application
  - d) **SC Need-based Grant Program** – for SC neediest students, must complete FAFSA
  - e) **Academic Common Market** – allows you to attend an out of state college without paying out-of-state tuition if your major is not offered in SC. For information and list of qualifying majors & colleges visit

- **SC Tuition Grant**  
Based on need and academic record (must be in top 75% of class OR have 900 on SAT (CR & Math) or 19 on ACT OR 2.0 GPA). Complete FAFSA no later than June 30, 2008. Good at 21 private colleges in SC. Visit [www.sctuitiongrants.com](http://www.sctuitiongrants.com) for information
- **Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarship Competition**  
Based on essay, leadership, academic record, and financial need. Download applications at [www.elks.org](http://www.elks.org) or pick up from Guidance Office. (500 scholarships will be awarded)  
Deadline: January 11
- **FAFSA**  
FAFSA forms will not be sent to high schools this year. You can access the form for 2008-09 at [www.FederalStudentAid.ed.gov](http://www.FederalStudentAid.ed.gov) or request up to 3 copies at 1-800-4-FED-AID. The forms cannot be completed until after January 1. More information will be provided about FAFSA after the Winter Break.
