### ❖ Kids Chance of South Carolina

Qualifications: Dependent upon someone who has been seriously or fatally injured as a result of a work-related accident or occupational disease. Worker must have been injured while working for a SC employer or as a self-employed resident of SC. The death or injury must have resulted in a substantial decline in family income. ### ❖ Southern Wesleyan University Scholarships

Minimum high school GPA of 2.25 and ACT composite of 17 / SAT of 800 may qualify you for a merit award. ### ❖ Fred and Mamie Bostic Scholarship

African-American, Minimum GPA of 2.5, three letters or recommendation, essay, financial need. Deadline: April 18, 2008. Applications available in Guidance.

### ❖ Major-Woodruff Educational Scholarship Program

Minority student attending Abbeville or Greenville County School, GPA of 2.5, enrolling in the fall in a program leading to a degree or certificate, three letters or recommendation, and essay. Applications available in Guidance. Deadline: June 1, 2008

Proof of acceptance and enrollment in college or technical school, financial need, "C" average. Applications are available in Guidance. Deadline: April 30, 2008

### ❖ Zonta International Virginia Wheelan Service Scholarship

Female member of the Class of 2008 at a Greenville County public high school, academic record, discipline and attendance records, participation in public service projects, and recommendations. Applications available in Guidance office. Deadline for receipt is April 18, 2008.
