

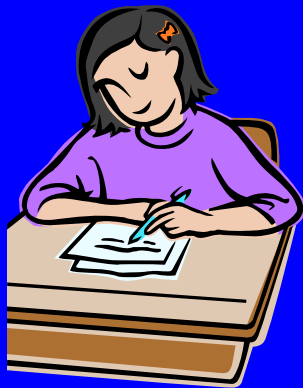
EOCEP Exams

Algebra I/Mathematics for Tech 2, Biology 1/Applied Biology 2, English I, Physical Science, and U.S. History and Constitution.

Exams Dates are:

January 6-8; 11-15

- Recheck your transcript for credit accuracy.
- Make sure you meet the requirements for all the colleges to which you want to apply.
- Double-check all applications and deadlines and apply.
- Take the ACT or SAT again in October and have the official scores sent by the testing agency to the colleges that have made your final list.
- Submit your college applications.
- Submit the Free Application for Student Financial Aid (FAFSA) as close to January 1st as possible.
- Decide on your college by May 1st.

SAT

Purpose and Content:

Assesses academic aptitude in Critical Reading, Mathematics, and Writing.

Scoring: Range of scores in each subtest is from 200 –800. Total subtest score is reported in range from 600-2400.

Cost: \$45.00 SAT Reasoning Test

Timeframe: 3 hours and 45 minutes

Test Administration Dates and Locations: Berea HS (B), Greenville HS (G), and Hillcrest HS (H). Registration deadline is in parentheses.

October 10, 2009—B, G, H (9/9)

November 7, 2009—B, G (10/1)

December 5, 2009—B, G, H (10/30)

January 23, 2010—B, G (12/15)

March 13, 2010—B, G, H (2/4)

May 1, 2010—G, H (3/25)

ACT

Purpose and Content:

Measures academic achievement in English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. The Writing subtest is optional.

Scoring: Scoring range on each subtest and on the composite score is 1-36, with 1 as the lowest score and 36 the highest.

Cost: \$32.00 (No Writing); \$47.00 (ACT Plus Writing)

Timeframe: 2 hours and 91 minutes

Testing Sites: Bob Jones Academy (B), Christ Church Episcopal School (C), and Greenville Technical College (G).

Test Administration Dates. Registration deadline is in parentheses.

October 24, 2009 (9/18) B, C, G

December 12, 2009 (11/6) B, C, G

February 6, 2010 (1/5) B, G

AP

Purpose and Content:

Assesses knowledge of specific content areas and potentially earns college credit from cooperating universities.

Scoring: On a scale of 1-5, with a 5 being the highest score.

Cost: None to students enrolled in an AP class.

Timeframe: Depending upon the exam, 90 minutes to 3 hours

Testing Sites: To be determined.
