

GUIDANCE DELIVERY SYSTEM

The Delivery System is a systematic way of delineating resources, staff responsibilities, and defining accountability in terms of results accomplished.

Counselors who work in a guidance department with more than one counselor at the site, in conjunction with their principal, decide how the students will be assigned and the counselor responsible for specific program components.

Students are assigned by:

Alphabet
Grade
Combination of alpha and grade

Program component responsibilities:

Divided by grade levels
Divided by counselor strength
