

Curriculum Template Greenville County Schools



This core curriculum template, which applies to all clusters of study, gives the basic core courses needed for graduation. To see the courses needed for a particular major, navigate to the cluster description to find courses and possible job opportunities. The courses that a student takes each year will depend on meeting the pre-requisites for the next course, the cluster of study, and the major. The student's guidance counselor can guide the student in the selection of courses.
