## First Semester Exam Schedule

**2011 - 2012**

The exam schedule for first semester exams is listed below and reflects a schedule that is consistent with the district requirements for exam schedules. Please note that classes on the block schedule are either full unit or half-unit classes and are listed as:

"AB" Day Classes - classes that meet every day first semester for a full 90 minutes (1.0 unit)

### Exam Notes:

1. Full Year English Classes (Skupaka, Martin, McCay) will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
2. Full Year Math Classes (Flounders, Ludley, Oberholzer) will administer one exam that will be the grade of record for both classes.
3. Students in first semester classes who take an End-of-Course Exam (US History CP, English I CP Genre Studies – semester only, English 1 Genre Analysis Honors, Algebra I CP Part B, Algebra I CP, Algebra I Honors, Biology 1 CP, and Biology 1 Honors) will have their exams January 5 - 10. Students in these classes MUST attend their regularly scheduled class period on exam days. Administer a final test in these classes that is sufficiently weighted as a major grade. We will not disrupt the school and others taking exams for early dismissals. Under no circumstance is it acceptable for a teacher to inform students or parents that the class has ended and their attendance is not required.
4. Exams must be comprehensive and challenging and should be sufficient in length to fully cover the 90 minutes allocated for the exam.

### Exam Rules:

1. The exam schedule is to be followed to the letter. No exams are to be administered early unless approved by the principal and no exams are to be administered at any other time than their scheduled times.
2. Every class at Greer High School will administer a 90 minute exam that covers the content of the curriculum taught and provides sufficient rigor and challenge. No class or student is exempt from exams.
3. Students who fail to stand the examination at the appointed time are to receive a zero.  
The principal will review absences of students and determine their eligibility to makeup missed exams. **DO NOT ADMINISTER ANY MAKE-UP EXAMINATIONS UNLESS APPROVED BY THE PRINCIPAL.**

**No early dismissals during examinations - exceptions only for medical, dental, funerals, and extreme emergency as excused by the building principal.**
