### Test Location:

West End Community Center (Across Vardry Street from the GHS student parking lot)

### Arrival time:

For morning exams, arrive at the Community Center no later than 7:30 AM.

For afternoon exams, arrive at the Community Center no later than 11:30 AM.

**Note: If you arrive after the administration of the exam has begun, you will not take the AP Exam.**

### Parking:

Park your cars in the student parking lot and walk across the street (at the traffic light) to the Community Center. Be careful in crossing the street.

### Materials needed:

- Several sharpened # 2 pencils with good erasers
- One blue or black ink pen (not felt tip)
- A calculator, if needed, with new batteries

### Materials allowed:

- Bottled water
- Hard candy
- A book to read if you finish the exam before the allotted time is up ... only reading material not related to the subject tested is allowed.

### Materials NOT allowed:

- Cell Phones or other communication devices – leave them in your car or at home ... **violation will result in your test being rendered invalid**
- Food and/or drinks (other than bottled water)

### Exam Requirements:

- No communication (talking, passing notes, hand signals, etc.) between you and any other student taking the AP Exam at any time for the duration of the test
- No one may be dismissed prior to verification of all test materials collected at the end of the exam

### Other:

You are responsible for making arrangements with teachers to make up work for all classes you miss during AP testing.
