Dear Parents and Students,

Each year we announce our school's standing with meeting the federal requirements of Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) as defined by the No Child Left Behind Act. AYP goals are set by the state and refer to our graduation rate and the percentage of tenth grade students and other second year high school students who perform Proficient or above (Level 3 or Level 4) on the High School Assessment Program (HSAP) tests for English/Language Arts and Mathematics.

For 2008-09, Greenville High School did not meet AYP. Our school met **13** of our **21** AYP target goals for the year.

Because we did not make Adequate Yearly Progress, our school will focus on ways to close achievement gaps and bring every student to the Proficient level (Level 3 or Level 4 on HSAP). **66.9%** of students overall at our school are performing at Level 3 or Level 4 on the High School Assessment Program (HSAP) test in Math and **70.3%** are performing at Level 3 or Level 4 in English/Language Arts on the HSAP. Our on-time graduation rate is **72%**

To meet AYP goals, high schools must annually achieve an 88.3% student graduation rate, meet or exceed last year's graduation rate, or meet or exceed its three-year average graduation rate. Also, tenth grade and other second year high school students must meet or exceed the following percentages of students scoring at Level 3 or Level 4 on the High School Assessment Program (HSAP) Tests:
