

Rising 6th Grade Curriculum information and processes: League Academy registration info for 2012-13

Here are the particulars for League Academy:

5th Grade teachers will recommend the appropriate English, Literature and Math level for each child using District criteria. The Science and Social Studies will be assigned since all regular education students take those classes.

English and Literature have 3 levels: (Recommended by 5th grade teachers)

We offer 2 Self-contained classes: LD and ED. We use a Tutorial Model for Resource, and it will be a related art class. Those assignments will be made through IEPs.

Teachers will make recommendations prior to Feb. 13, 2012. During the week of Feb. 13, students will be given the opportunity to “accept” the recommendations made by their academic teachers and enter their first choices for related arts classes.

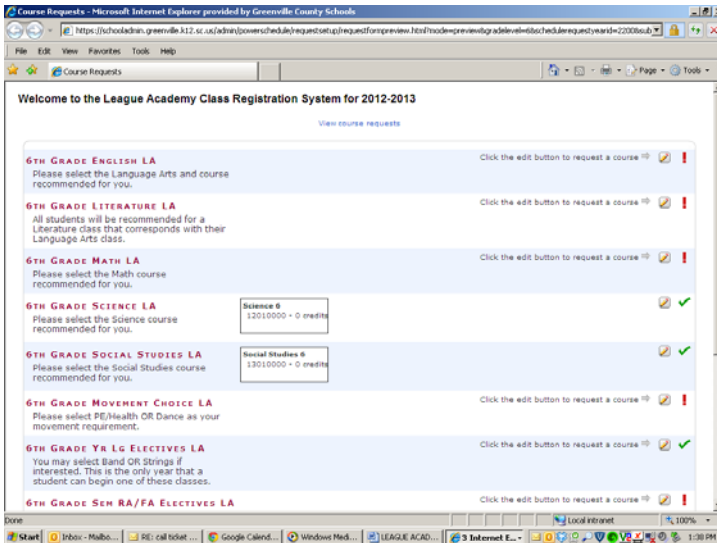

The order for those selections will be as follows:

1. Please accept the core subject area selection that your teachers have recommended. (English, Literature, Math, Science and Social Studies)
2. Choose PE/Health or Dance.
3. If interested in taking Band or Strings, select that next. These are year-long courses, and count for 2 of your 4 possible semesters of related arts. If you have had previous STRINGS instruction, please indicate that on the BACK of your registration form when you take it home to be signed.

4. Select your choice(s) of a semester related/fine arts class. If you selected Band or Strings, select only one (1) additional choice. If you have only selected PE/Health or Dance, you need to select three (3) additional choices here.
5. You will receive a printout of your choices. **If you want to prioritize the remaining related/fine arts choices in case you do not get your first choices, please WRITE THEM ON THE BOTTOM OR BACK OF THAT SHEET IN PRIORITY ORDER. If no courses are WRITTEN, you will be placed in a related/fine arts class with space available.**

PARENTS: Here is where we need your help even more! We know that with so many choices, it is unlikely that kids will all be able to get their first choices of related/fine arts. **If students/parents want to let us know the priority of their other choices, they need to WRITE THEM ON THE BACK OF THE FORM when you send it home to get signed. Since their chosen choices will be listed in alphabetical order, you might encourage them to INCLUDE them in the priority order list written on the back if they so choose.** If nothing is written, they will be placed in related/fine arts electives with room available.

SPECIAL EDUCATION INFORMATION: We have two self-contained classes – EDSC and LDSC. The self-contained teachers will need to make the appropriate recommendation for English and Math. We will do the Science and Social Studies. **RESOURCE:** We use a Tutorial model for resource. It will be offered during related arts – those students should choose regular related arts classes, and we will make the adjustment based on their IEP.
