

Rising 7th Grade Curriculum information and processes: League Academy registration info for 2012-13

Here are the particulars for League Academy:

6th Grade teachers will recommend the appropriate English, Literature and Math level for each child using District guidelines. The Science and Social Studies will be assigned since all regular education students take those classes.

English and Literature have 3 levels: (Recommended by 6th grade teachers)

Language Arts Strategies 7 (Grade Level)	20014000

**** For 8th grade (2013-14), ENGLISH GT 8 will be ENGLISH 1H – there will not be a separate English GT 8 class.**

Math has 3 levels: (Recommended by 6th grade teachers)

Math 7(Grade Level)	21100500
Math 8 for 7(Advanced)	21100800
Algebra IH	411103HW

We offer 2 Self-contained classes: LD and ED. We use a Tutorial Model for Resource, and it will be a related art class. Those assignments will be made through IEPs.

Teachers will make recommendations prior to Feb. 13, 2012. During the week of Feb. 13, students will be given the opportunity to “accept” the recommendations made by their academic teachers and enter their first choices for related arts classes.

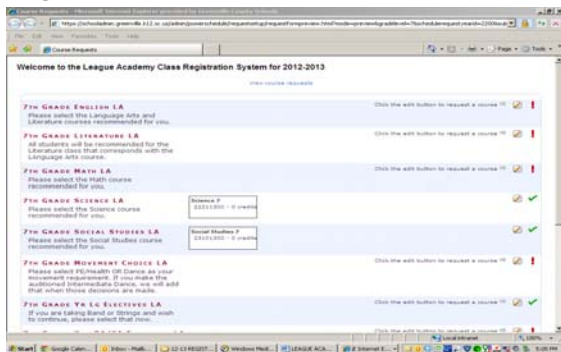

The order for those selections will be as follows:

1. Students will accept the core subject area selection that their teachers have recommended. (English, Literature, Math, Science and Social Studies)
2. Choose PE/Health or Dance.
3. If interested in continuing Band or Strings, select that next. These are year-long courses, and count for 2 of 4 possible semesters of related arts.

4. Select choice(s) of a semester related/fine arts class. If Band or Strings is selected, there will only be one (1) additional choice. If only PE/Health or Dance have been selected, there are three (3) additional choices remaining.
5. If your child plans to audition for an intermediate arts class (Art, Dance, Drama, Chorus and/or Newspaper), they will need to enter choices in the computer AS IF THEY DID NOT MAKE THE AUDITIONED CLASS. Auditions are not held until March and April, and we will put them in the correct auditioned class if they make it. Some students will have made more than one, and will have to rank them in priority order.
6. **Students will receive a printout of their choices. If you want to prioritize the remaining related/fine arts choices in case you do not get your first choices, please WRITE THEM ON THE BOTTOM OR BACK OF THAT SHEET IN PRIORITY ORDER. If no courses are WRITTEN, you will be placed in a related/fine arts class with space available.**

PARENTS: Here is where we need your help even more! We know that with so many choices, it is unlikely that kids will all be able to get their first choices of related/fine arts. **If students/parents want to let us know the priority of their other choices, they need to WRITE THEM ON THE BACK OF THE FORM when you send it home to get signed. Since their chosen choices will be listed in alphabetical order, you might encourage them to INCLUDE them in the priority order list written on the back if they so choose.** If nothing is written, they will be placed in related/fine arts electives with room available.
