Grade Progression

Students are classified to number of units earned.

10th grade: 5 units-1 English, 1 Math, 3 others

11th grade: 11 units-2 English, 2 Math, 1 Science, 6 others

12th grade: 17 units-3 English, 3 Math, 2 Science, 9 others

Testing

End of Course (EOC) Tests: all students enrolled in Algebra 1, Algebra 1 Part B, Biology, English 1, and US History.

HSAP (Exit Exam): all students will test for the first time in April during their second year of high school.

ASVAB: Given in the fall, students may sign up in guidance. This measures career and academic abilities.

PSAT: Given annually in October, all sophomores will test free of charge. For a small fee, any college-bound junior is encouraged to test.

SAT/ACT: College entrance exam given periodically throughout the year at various Greenville County locations. Information on registration can be found at www.collegeboard.com (SAT) and www.act.org (ACT). Tests are not administered at TRHS. Testing sites can be found on the websites.
