#### **Revised Bid Form**

Please see the attached revised bid form. A Unit Price has been added for Compactable Fill/ Unsuitable Soil Replacement per Ton. Only the **Revised Bid Form** is to be used.

#### **Inquiries/ District Responses**

Before the solicitation inquiry deadline, the District received an inquiry regarding this solicitation. The District's response to the question follows in **bold** font.

1.) On the Full Depth Repair, if soft and yielding soils occur how do you want to handle this? Unit rate price? For asphalt and/or crusher run.

See enclosed Revised Bid Form.

2.) GCS provided a table of site conditions (LF cracks, SY FDRs, SY seal, Bulk Gallons Required). I would like to clarify that the last column, Bulk Gallons Required, shows only the amount of Gallons for 1 coat. For example, line 1, Alexander Elem, has 8159sy and 816g required. This would only be for one coat (or per coat); however, the true total for that site should be 1,632 Gs. If not clarified, some vendors would be quoting half the material and would alter their bid price significantly.

In SECTION C – SITE MAPS, LOCATION OF FULL DEPTH REPAIRS, AND REQUIRED DRAWINGS – In the table listed as: <u>Assessed Site Conditions as of Summer of 2019</u>, the values listed under the column titled: <u>Sealcoat - Required Bulk Gallons of Product</u>, these gallon quantities are for one coat. To meet the specified requirements of the solicitation, these quantities would be doubled. EX: Alexander Elem  $816 \times 2 = 1632$  gallons to meet the specification and requirements of this solicitation.

3.) Time has passed since site assessments have been done, so LF of cracks and SY of failures has likely grown by some small percent. Do we price for the #s provided, and then include unit pricing for extra LF of crackseal and extra SY (or tons) of Full Depth Repairs?

This is at the contractor's discretion. This bid is for a turn-key product and the numbers are based on assessments from 2019. The district expects all cracks and full depth repairs to be done. The contractor is to determine amount for their bid price. No unit cost will be asked.
