What do I do when my certificate has been issued by the SDE?

If your certificate is issued **before** your start date:

• Print a copy of your certificate and email it to HRProcessingcenter@greenville.k12.sc.us. Please write your employee number AND "New Hire" on the certificate for processing.

If your certificate is issued **after** your start date:

• Print a copy of your certificate and email it to certificate@greenville.k12.sc.us. Please write your employee number AND "New Hire" on the certificate for processing.

I have National Board Certification. Will I receive a stipend?

NBCTs receive a stipend based on your original application date. In order to receive the stipend you must provide a SC Teaching Certificate reflecting NB status. Original application dates prior to July 1, 2009 will receive \$7,500 per year paid over 10 months. Original application dates after July 1, 2009 will receive \$5,000 per year paid over 10 months.
