RE: Professional Learning Opportunity for Elementary School Administrators

The Office of Early Learning and Literacy (OELL) supports South Carolina's districts and schools in providing professional learning opportunities around building teacher capacity through coaching. This memo offers information regarding a free professional development opportunity for elementary school administrators. During summer 2017, the OELL will offer a free, professional learning series for school administrators that consist of face-to-face experiences. In addition, this professional learning opportunity provides school districts with virtual and onsite support by the OELL's regional literacy specialists during the 2017–18 school year.

This professional learning series is designed to:

- ensure that all school administrators are equipped with the tools to build a foundation of literacy leadership for coaching;
- provide guidance on looking closely at a comprehensive system for coaching; and
- support Read to Succeed coaches in data analysis by looking closely at data to inform systemic growth within a comprehensive system of coaching.

Participants engage in a learning experience based on research and best practices of administrative leadership for coaching. Learning opportunities focus on background knowledge for coaching, administrative leadership for coaching, and principles of adult learning for coaching. Participants have opportunities to explore how to build teacher capacity for success as part of a system that moves learners forward in growth and achievement.
