Goal One: Student Achievement

- Absolute Status Rating of Excellent on the SC Annual District Report Card
- \$118.5 million in college scholarship offers to Class of 2015
- Average ACT score by GCS college-bound students consistently exceeds the state and national average
- Average SAT score by GCS college-bound students above state and nation
- Increasing numbers of AP tests given and passed
- GCS boasts 19 National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists (2014-2015)
- Outperformed the state in Science and Social Studies at all grade levels on PASS in 2014 and 2015



Goal One: Student Achievement

- 98% of our schools earned ratings of Excellent, Good, or Average on School Report Card
- 410% enrollment increase in career classes moved to high school campuses
- Graduation rate (84.2%) up 11.8 points over 5 years
- Three subgroups are closing the gap by outpacing District rate of improvement and all are at or above 78%
 - * African American up 15 points
 - * Hispanic up 13 points
 - * Limited English Proficiency up 13 points

This includes ACT, SAT, Workkeys, ITBS, and CogAT.



Greenville County Schools FY 16 Budgeted Expenditures



FY 16 All Other Budgeted Expenditures \$64,904,000


