### Medical Homebound Instruction Program

Medical homebound instruction is provided for students who are recovering at home due to illness, accident, or pregnancy. A licensed physician must certify that a medical condition exists and must complete and sign the Medical Homebound form. The intent of medical homebound instruction is to keep students connected to their regular curriculum until the student can return to their classroom setting.
