

When should my child return to school after an illness?

In an effort to decrease the spread of contagious illness at school, Greenville County School District would like to remind you of the following:

If your student has **fever**, he/she must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school (this means without the use of fever reducing medications). Fever is defined as a temperature of 100.4 or greater.

If your student has **diarrhea**, he/she must be diarrhea free for 24 hours before returning to school (this mean without the use of diarrhea suppressing medication). Diarrhea is defined as 3 or more episodes of loose stools in a 24 hour period.

A student must not come to school if **vomiting** 2 or more times in 24 hours. A student should have 1 or 2 meals without vomiting before returning to school.
