SIC introductions

Brice- Reviewed the school data and shared the 22-23 goals. He also shared the current school demographics:

59% school choice  
Highest sub group- African American  
Poverty Index- 68.4%

ELA meets/exceeds percentage: 64%, District: 59.1%  
Math meets/exceeds percentage: 63.5%, District: 59%  
Science meets/exceed percentage: 60.5%

Goal: 3% higher than current meets/exceeds percentage  
67% ELA  
67% Math

Benchmarks: the fall benchmark is at the end of October with the results coming in early November. Is there a way that we can get the students more involved? More motivated? Benchmarks are 3x year; Fall, Winter and Spring.

Food drive- class competition; What are the needs of the community?

Dr. Battle shared what they are doing in the community- worked with the Men's shelter. He said he will talk to some contacts to see where the greatest need is. He will get back to us.
