Reading Program

- Mrs. Crawford has been reaching out to volunteers. We have about 9 volunteers at this time. Looking for 2 days a week. About 8 sessions a month. Days: Monday and Friday.
- Volunteers would need to be a level 2 approved chaperone. With PTA, we are hoping to get some sponsorships in order to provide students with goodies for participating in the program.
- Mrs. Crawford sent Dr. Battle an email about Monday volunteers on the carline-potentially have them help with the reading program.
- Possibly having two students per volunteer depending on what curriculum is being used. Can use the books in the bookroom that would match their level. It would have lesson plans and questions to ask kids.
- Johanna will help pull books and group students once they are identified.
- 1st and 2nd grade will be the focus. We are working with the teachers to identify students that would benefit from the reading program. It will be from 7:30-8. We need to make sure that students get breakfast.
- We will send home parent letters to let them know about the program and to get permission to attend.
- Volunteers will be spread out in different designated areas on the first and second floor.
- To kick start the program, we will have an orientation that discusses expectations and facilitates a meet and greet.
- Example schedule: 10 volunteers 5 Monday, 5 Friday. Goal is to get enough volunteers to rotate them out so it would not be every week.
- Looking at this like a pilot program in order to improve for next year. Possibly looking to kick off in March instead of previous February due to events and time.
- In February, we will have a list of students and will send home parent letters to get an idea of how many students. We will look at transportation and other factors to help identify students.
