 - *Academic Achievement*: We received an excellent rating.
 - *Preparing for Success*: 4th grade science received an excellent rating.
 - *Multilingual Learners' Progress*: average rating. Tracks students in the ML subgroup who met progress toward proficiency target, and students who achieved ELA level proficiency.
 - *Student Progress*: Average score. Every student has an individual growth target goal. It is set in 3rd grade, and we receive points based on if students meet the growth goals. We have room to grow for individual growth targets.
