 RE: Greenville County Athletic Accident Insurance (POLICY# US1182265)

The School District of Greenville County has an athletic accident insurance policy in place for all student athletes, cheerleaders and team managers participating in interscholastic sports/activities in Middle School and High School as well as for the Work-Based Learning Program (excludes sports).

All Student Athletes are required to have this coverage! The coverage is for interscholastic sports play/practice only and is not 24 hour accident coverage. This plan is not a health insurance plan!

ELIGIBILITY	Sports Middle School and High School: Senior High Athletes, Cheerleaders and Team Members Middle School Athletes, Cheerleaders, Team Members, Work Based Learning Students Field Trips: Grades K-12 All Students
BENEFIT PERIOD	52 weeks from the date of covered injury.
<i>Claims will be paid EXCESS of all other insurance for eligible injuries incurred during the policy period of the related expenses incurred within the benefit period. Please refer to the Policy for specific benefits and details.</i>
