



A History of Excellence

Brushy Creek Elementary School has a long history of excellence in education, care, and concern for students and a strong involvement within the community. Strategic Plan

A Record of Results

The ACT Aspire test measured student performance on the South Carolina academic standards. Student score percentages are based on three levels: Exceeding, Ready, and Close. Below are 2014-2015 test results:
