Please take time to learn about some of the programs which are planned for this year at Brushy Creek Elementary. Keep this form for reference and use the Volunteer Opportunities Interest Form to indicate how you might be interested in getting involved.

**Author's Café** (throughout the year) - Students' writings are selected and showcased at this event. Volunteers are needed for set up and decorating prior to this event.

**Book Fair** (November) - Students visit the book fair during their scheduled library time and before/after school. Volunteers assist students with selecting their books and with sales.

**Boosterthon** (September) – Volunteers are needed to cheer on students and hand out water at the Fun Run.

**Field Day** (June) – Students participate in fun activities with their class. Volunteers are needed to supervise and facilitate activity stations.

Gives Back (throughout the year) – Collection of Box Tops and Target Charge of Education.

**Holiday Boutique** (December) – This is an event during which the students shop for Christmas gifts for family members. Volunteers are needed to set up/breakdown, sell items, help children make choices and wrap gifts.

**Night of the Arts** (December) – Volunteers needed to decorate cafeteria stage and Christmas trees and to hang artwork in hallways for display prior to Night of the Arts program.

**Red Ribbon Week** (October) – This national observance encourages students to take a stand against the misuse of drugs. Volunteers are needed to implement the week long observance.

**School Store** – Volunteers are needed to help before school to sell items in the school store.

**Spike's Spooktacular** (October) - This is BCES's fall carnival. Volunteers will help with booths, games, and food.

**Spike's Study Buddies** (throughout the year) – This in-school tutoring program seeks volunteers who enjoy working one-on-one with students and making a difference in their education. No previous experience is necessary, scheduling is flexible, and you can make a difference in as little as 30 minutes a week.

**Spirit Night** (throughout the year) - PTA coordinates events at local businesses to allow BCES students, staff, and family members to socialize outside of school hours and raise money for the school. Volunteers help promote Spirit Night fundraisers at school and greet guests at the event.

**Staff Appreciation** (May) - Volunteers help during Teacher/Staff appreciation week.

**Swim Night** (throughout the year) - BCES students are invited to swim at the local YMCA.

**Teacher Lunch Break** – Volunteers sign up to bring in food, desserts, or paper products for the quarterly Teacher Lunch Break.
