Palmetto Pride Art Contest Application Guidelines

PalmettoPride knows that South Carolina students are creative and care about the environment. Our annual art contest is available to any South Carolina K-5th grade teachers or educational groups to participate in this fun and educational competition.

Directions: Students will create an artwork based on the theme *Litter Trashes Everyone*, on either the paper provided by PalmettoPride *OR* a white sheet of paper no smaller than 14×8.5 inches.

Tips for a good entry:

1. Artwork must depict an original interpretation of the theme. “Litter Trashes Everyone”
2. Poster design. Draw your design on the dull side of the poster.
3. Write the theme **Litter Trashes Everyone** on your poster in Free-hand or with stencil in Block or Bubble font.
4. Use strong bold, vibrant, and brilliant color. **Do not leave white space in the foreground and background.**
5. Materials: Crayons, Markers, Colored pencils, Gel pens, Watercolors, etc. **Do not use oil pastels.**
6. Space and Composition: Draw “BIG”. Fill the negative space with positive elements.

8. We will pick a winning poster to represent our school in this competition.
