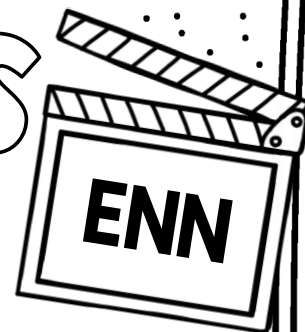


EAGLE NEWS NETWORK



We are excited you are interested in auditioning to be a part of the daily news program (ENN) at Bell's Crossing. It is a privilege to be the "face of the news." This job is one that carries a lot of responsibility.

As a member of the ENN crew, you would be assigned one of these jobs:

Reporter Positions	Technician Positions
(4) On-Air Anchor	(2) Teleprompter Operator
(2) Meteorologist	(2) Sound Technician
(4) Roaming Reporter	(2) Set Technician
(2) Script Writer	(2) Live Streamer

Circle the 3 jobs above that interest you the most. While you would be assigned a main job, you would also be expected to fill-in with other positions, if the need arises.

Please read the **EXPECTATIONS for ENN** carefully before signing.

- 1. Punctuality** – ENN Crew should be at school and in place in the ENN room at 7:40 each morning during their assigned weeks (there will be two ENN Crew teams alternating weeks throughout the school year). If a student has 3 unexcused tardies/absences, he/she will be dismissed from the crew so that the job may be filled by a dependable alternate.
- 2. Behavior** – You must remain in good standing to be part of the ENN crew. If you get a detention or referral, you will be replaced. There is **NO ROOM** for misbehavior in the studio. You must be responsible as an ENN crew member.
- 3. Academics** – You must do your classwork and homework. You must return to class promptly after ENN. If your teacher feels that you are not studying or that your ENN job interferes with your academics, you will be asked to take a leave of absence until your academics improve.

All interested crew members will have a scheduled audition. Audition times will be scheduled after scripts have been submitted (script details below). Auditions will consist of a sample ENN broadcast written by the student ahead of time PLUS "cold read" segments on audition day. Please submit a script to Mrs. Madden at amadden@greenville.k12.sc.us by Wednesday, April 24th. Any late submissions will result in no audition.

Scripts should include:

- An Introduction – a creative introduction to catch the viewers' attention
- Weather – a sample weather forecast for the day
- Menu – a sample menu for the day
- Announcement – a special school announcement
- Closing – an interesting phrase to close the broadcast
