


# Completer Ceremony for Greenville County Schools Bon Secours Wellness Arena May 31, 2018 6:30 PM

## Important Information

All students who are career center “completers” of a program will be honored at the district-wide completer ceremony.

- Completers (students) must arrive at the Bon Secours Wellness Arena at 5:45 pm.



- A limited number of pre-printed parking permits will be available for students so students are requested to car pool. Each parking permit will allow one car to park in the VIP lot at the Bon Secours Arena. The VIP lot is on Church Street near the parking garage (not in the parking garage). Career Centers will determine how to distribute the parking permits at their discretion. Completers will enter the building through the “Sandlapper” entrance.

- For GPS Directions to the VIP lot use address: 401 North Church Street, Greenville

- Students are expected to wear what they will wear to their high school graduation.
  - **Men:** It is recommended that men wear dark trousers or khakis, dark socks, shoes, and a dress shirt with a tie underneath the gown. Jeans and shorts, sandals and tennis shoes should be avoided.
  - **Women:** Women should wear dress, dark slacks, or skirt, and a light-colored dress blouse with dark shoes. High heels are not recommended for reasons of safety and comfort; flats or pumps are suggested. Sandals and tennis shoes should not be worn.
- Participants will wear their graduation GOWN (not the cap). If you do not have a graduation gown, you may borrow one for the evening IF you indicate on the RSVP form that you need one. If you indicate that you need to borrow a gown, it will be available when you arrive at the ceremony. There will be an area set up near the student entrance where you will pick up a gown, if requested
- Students will report to the arena floor where you will find a seat with your name on a notecard. Please sit in your designated seat where assigned. Hold on to the notecard as you will bring that to the stage with you so the announcer will know who you are.
- Tickets are not needed for guests. Each completer may invite as many guests as they want.
- Doors will open for guests at 6:00 pm. Guests will use the “Clemson” entrance.
- There will be no specific reserved seats.

# Bon Secours Arena Clear Bag Policy

## PLEASE NOTE

Beginning on Friday, October 13, 2017, the Bon Secours Wellness Arena will implement a clear bag policy for **all events**, including hockey, concerts and family events.

Each guest will be permitted to carry one large clear bag, either a Ziploc style bag or a 12"x6"x12" clear bag, plus a small clutch purse (4.5"x6.5"). The small clutch must be carried into the venue outside the clear bag and is subject to search.

"The safety and security of our guests is of utmost importance at our events," says Beth Paul, General Manager of the Bon Secours Wellness Arena. "Many of our patrons may already be familiar with this process, as it is used by many arenas and college and NFL stadiums."

Clear bags provide another layer of security with less inconvenience to our guests as they are easier and faster to search. It also supports the Department of Homeland Security's "See Something, Say Something" campaign.

### **Approved bags include:**

- Bags that are clear, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12"x6"x12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags, with or without a handle or strap, that do not exceed 4.5"x6.5"

An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection upon entry.

### **Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to:**

- Purses larger than a clutch bag
- Briefcases
- Backpacks
- Cinch bags
- Fanny packs that are not clear and exceed size restriction

Diapers and other baby supplies can be carried in a clear bag. Each member of a family, including children, is allowed to carry an approved clear bag and a clutch purse into the arena.

Complimentary clear bags will be available to guests attending events as we transition through this new policy.
