Blue Ridge High School Parking Permit regulations 2021-2022

- 1. DRIVING TO SCHOOL IS A PRIVILEGE NOT A RIGHT.
- 2. Parking tags cost **\$30.00*** for full-year students and **\$15.00*** for early graduates or purchases made after Winter Break. Tags will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis for students who meet the criteria below:
- *Completed Alive at 25 class prior to purchase of parking tag. (register for the class at https://scnsc.org/training/alive-at-25)
 *ALL school debt must be cleared and current year class fees paid
- *ALL school debt must be cleared and current year class fees paid
 *Show proof of valid driver's license and insurance
- *Return this signed contract

*Bus lot parking is an extra \$10.00 per year (67 spots available)

- 3. Students are assigned parking by lot bus lot, senior lot, or underclassmen lot. Students cannot change lots and must park where their tag indicates. Parking in the wrong lot will result in a ticket. Please see #5 for details. Parking tags are not transferable. All students will need to purchase new tags each year.
- 4. Parking privileges can be suspended or revoked at any time by administration for unsafe driving or behavior in the parking lot and within the proximity of the school or for failure to adhere to any part of this contract. Examples) Speeding, peeling out of the parking lot, driving recklessly inside the parking lot.
- 5. Your parking tag allows you to park in a specified area on campus. The entire campus is checked for cars parked illegally. Consequences for parking in the wrong area or for parking on campus without a tag are listed below:
- 1st offense = Warning, 2nd offense = \$10, 3rd offense = \$25, and 4th offense = car booted at owners expense & \$75 fee to have boot removed. (Students who try to remove or who damage the car boot in any way will be responsible for replacing the boot which costs in excess of \$500.)
- 6. When tickets are paid it does not revert the student back to zero parking offenses. A record is kept of all parking offenses. Unpaid fines will be added to the student's debt.
- 7. Traffic is not allowed to ENTER the main student parking lot between 3:30-4:00 p.m. unless school related.
- 8. ALL DRIVERS MUST MAINTAIN **5 MPH** OR LESS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY DURING SCHOOL HOURS. Drivers will not drive through parking spaces to locate a spot. Drivers will drive in the appropriate lanes.
- 9. All cars parked on school grounds during the day will display a current parking tag. Parking tags are to be displayed on the rear view mirror. It is the sole responsibility of the student to hang the tag in a highly visible manner. Parking tickets written for not being able to see the hanging tag will not be forgiven.
- 10. Cars parked on campus without a valid parking tag will be subject to being booted at the owner's expense.
- 11. All students must park within the parking space lines. DO NOT USE MORE THAN ONE SPACE. Do not park on the sidewalks or grass.
- 12. No loitering in parking lot upon arrival, whether inside or outside of car, will be allowed. <u>Once students arrive at school</u>, they must immediately park and enter the school. If students are found in parked cars, they will be disciplined for being in an unauthorized area.
- 13. During the fall semester ALL students must exit the parking lot with their vehicle by 4 p.m. on Friday afternoons. The parking lot is used by the athletic booster club during football games. Cars not moved by 4 p.m. are subject to being towed.
- 14. No one will take another student from the campus in his/her car without parent/guardian authorization.
- 15. No one will go into the parking lot during the school day without administrative approval.
- 16. Students classified as 9th graders will not be issued a parking tag, regardless of age.
- 17. There will be consequences for tardies for student drivers that will involve suspended parking. See the 2021-2022 student handbook on our website for details.
 - Parking will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - No refunds will be given if a student withdraws from BRHS, remains in the 9th grade, will not drive, or for other reasons the student or guardian may request.
