- ◆ Guest **must be between the ages of 14 and 20.**
- ◆ Guest **must be currently enrolled in the regular high school program, be a high school graduate OR have earned a G.E.D.** (students will not be permitted if they are enrolled in alternative school, have been expelled or recommended for expulsion or have any serious prior or current discipline record.) **A copy of the guest's diploma or G.E.D. must be attached.**
- ◆ The student and guest **must wear appropriate, formal attire.** Read the back of this page for the dress code and sign stating that you agree to abide by the dress code.
- ◆ Non-Blue Ridge High School students will need prior approval before attending the dance. **Turn this form in to Mrs. Lynch-Miner so she may contact your guest's school prior to ticket purchase.**

Snow Ball DRESS CODE

The Snow Ball, is a semi-formal social event; therefore, everyone attending the dance, including guests, is expected to dress and behave appropriately for a semiformal event. Examples include but are not limited to:

- Gentlemen- dress pants (khakis, slacks, etc.) and a collared shirt, button down shirt, ties, etc
- Ladies- Dresses may **not** expose a bare midriff. Mesh or see-through inserts in the midriff area will not be allowed. Front, back, and sides of attire must not be too low-cut or revealing. Short dresses or side slits may not be higher than mid-thigh. Do not hike up dresses in order to dance. Dress pants are also appropriate for girls.
- No jeans, flip-flops, or athletic shoes.

If not appropriately dressed, you will not be allowed to enter the dance. No refund will be given. If you have any questions, contact the Mrs. Sorrells (B105) or Mrs. Fryer (D123). Remember, if in doubt, don't wear it!

Students and guests may be asked to leave if attire or behavior becomes inappropriate or conflicts with school rules. *Faculty members will make the final decision regarding appropriate attire and behavior.*
