- ◆ Guest must be between the ages of 14 and 20.
- ◆ **ALL SCHOOL DEBTS MUST BE PAID!!**
- ◆ Guest **must be currently enrolled in the regular high school program, be a high school graduate OR have earned a G.E.D.** (students will not be permitted if they are enrolled in alternative school, have been expelled or recommended for expulsion or have any serious prior or current discipline record.) **A copy of the guest's diploma or G.E.D. must be attached.**
- ◆ The student and guest **must wear appropriate, casual attire.** Read the bottom of this page for the dress code and sign stating that you agree to abide by the dress code.
- ◆ Non-Blue Ridge High School students will need prior approval before purchasing a ticket.

SADIE HAWKINS DANCE DRESS CODE

Everyone attending the dance, including guests, is expected to dress and behave appropriately for a school sponsored event. The dress code includes but is not limited to:

- Gentlemen - no athletic shirts or shorts; nice casual attire – khakis, jeans (ripped jeans must meet school dress code), polo-shirts, nice t-shirts, etc.
- Ladies- You may **not** expose a bare midriff and shirts must not be too low-cut or revealing. Short dresses, skirts or side slits may not be higher than mid-thigh. Do not hike up dresses in order to dance. Pants/Jean are also appropriate for girls. Ripped jeans must meet school dress code. No athletic clothes.
- No shower type flip-flops.

If you are not appropriately dressed, you will not be allowed to enter the dance. No refund will be given. If you have any questions, contact the Mrs. Skinner (D117) or Mrs. Roddey (D122). Remember, if in doubt, don't wear it!

Students and guests may be asked to leave if attire or behavior becomes inappropriate or conflicts with school rules. *Faculty members will make the final decision regarding appropriate attire and behavior.*
