

## **Bryson Middle School eLearning Information**

Greenville County Schools offers eLearning Days in case we are not able to learn in the building. GCS will announce the eLearning Days as they have announced inclement weather days in the past. If an in-person school day is canceled, then students will move to an eLearning mode as directed by GCS. Below are the directions for eLearning.

### **Student expectations:**

- In order to be marked as present, students are expected to:
  - Attend all live meeting sessions for each of your classes
  - Login to each of their Google Classrooms
  - Complete the assignment
  - Complete the assignment
  - Submit the completed work
- Students are expected to complete their work in all of their classes, including Related Arts classes.
- Students should email their teachers with any questions they may have after the live session is complete.
- The schedule is set-up so you are able to attend on the same schedule as you are used to during a normal school day. You will feel more in-control when you complete work on a daily routine.
- Please remember, school building rules continue to apply for eLearning.

### **Google Meet Expectations:**

- Students should be dressed appropriately during the live sessions (No pajamas or revealing clothing. Shirt and appropriate bottoms are required).
- Students should be on time and prepared.
  - Computer is charged
  - Camera is on and the student is in view.
  - Use headphones if you have them
- Students should check their surroundings and ensure they are in a quiet place. All Chromebooks should be muted unless speaking. If a student is lying down or not prepared for learning, teachers will remove them from the meet and they will be counted absent for the class period.
- Participate:
  - Be focused
  - Be attentive
  - Be an active participant
- Chat Responsibly
  - Raise your hand to speak
  - Type your questions in the chat box
  - Speak clearly
  - Stay on topic
