First Ebola Outbreak in US

A patient is now being treated at a hospital in Dallas. They're diagnosed with the first case of Ebola in the United States, which was announced Tuesday. The man had just came back from Liberia on September 20 and left there on the day before. When he first got back he had shown no symptoms but less than 4 or 5 days he started showing he was sick. The man has been isolated since Sunday at Texas Health Presbyterian Hospital. Any details about the man have been declined to be released. It's been declined to say if he's an American citizen. The patient was visiting family members and staying with ones who live in America. The patient is believed to have had physical contact with a handful of others since he'd returned from Liberia. On Wednesday there will be a news conference held by the Governor, Rick Perry. Crew member who transported the patient to the hospital have also been isolated.



None have shown symptoms so far though. The ambulance was only used for 2 days and then decontaminated after the transporting. There are currently no other reported cases in Texas. Ebola is a severe disease, which has a high fatality rate, even with the best care. It causes viral hemorrhagic fever, which can affect multiple organs systems systems in the body and is often accompanied by bleeding. The symptoms include sudden onset of fever, weakness, muscle pain, headaches and a sore throat, each which can easily mistaken early on for other ailments like malaria, typhoid fever and meningitis. It's spread by direct contact with someone sick with this virus which is common sense.

Japan



A volcano erupted in Japan killing 36 people. The volcano, 10,161 feet high erupted without warning around 11:53 a.m. Saturday, on the border of the Nagano and Gifu prefectures.

The work by police, firefighters and the Japanese Self-Defense Forces had to stop due to high hydrogen sulfide levels on the volcano. The eruption also injured at least 60 people and left 250 climbers trapped. The Japanese Meteorological Agency issued a Level 3 volcano alert, urging people to stay away from the area.

Iraq

The Iraqi military command has begun a campaign to re-enlist soldiers and officers who abandoned their units, a crucial step in its effort to rebuild an army that has been routed in battle after battle by Islamic State jihadists. Army officials at re-enlistment centers in Baghdad and in the northern Kurdistan region say they have seen some success in the effort. More than 6,000 soldiers and officers, including those who were sent home by their commanders as well as those who fled unilaterally, had registered at a military outpost in Kurdistan, and more than 5,000 had signed up in Baghdad.

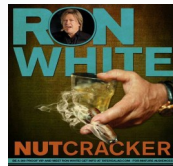

It's the Law!

In New Jersey, all motorists must honk before passing another car, bicyclist, skater, and even a skateboarder. This law came to order because many citizens on bikes, etc. would be injured in a wreck. By honking, the cars warn them they are behind or going to pass.



In 1966 the Shelby GT350 was equipped with a 289 cubic-inch V8 engine that produced 306 horsepower. A bolt-on Paxton supercharger increased horsepower by 46% to an estimated 360 horsepower. The fastback C-pillar vents were replaced with Plexiglas quarter windows. The side air scoops were functional and allowed air to flow to the brakes which kept them cool. The hood was comprised of fiberglass but partway through the year it was

replaced with a steel version due to customer complaints about weakness and lack of quality. The only color offered for the interior was black. Other interior items were the competition seat belts, roll bar, and GT 350 center cap found on the steering wheel.

Betta fish are easy to care for but, also need some special tank requirements. They are colorful fish but only get along with certain fish on the right circumstances. They can live in low-oxygen water environments, but only for a short period of time. The males are more colorful than the females. The Betta males are aggressive fish. A 5-gallon tank is better for the fish. You have to clean the tank weekly. Bettas don't like fast currents. When you do clean the tank don't use a fish net, use a small cup or bowl and they jump so be careful. The tank always has to be room temperature. Bettas need places to hide and plants in the tank but only a few.
