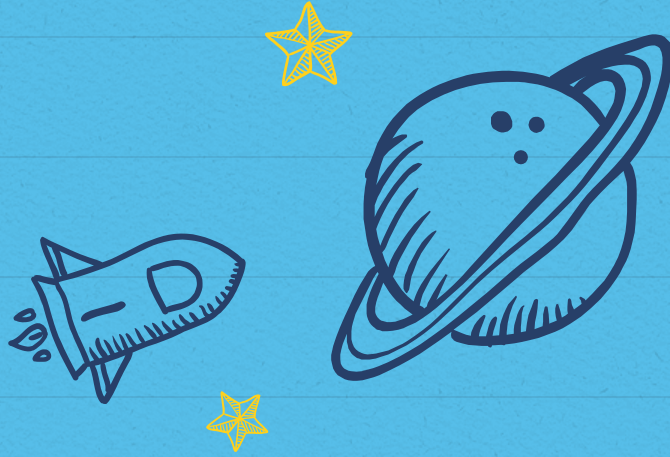
PURPOSE OF TITLE I

Districts and schools with higher percentages of children from low-income families

"THE PURPOSE OF TITLE I IS TO ENABLE SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES TO CHILDREN SERVED TO ACQUIRE THE KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS CONTAINED IN CHALLENGING STATE CONTENT STANDARDS AND TO MEET THE CHALLENGING STATE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR ALL CHILDREN."

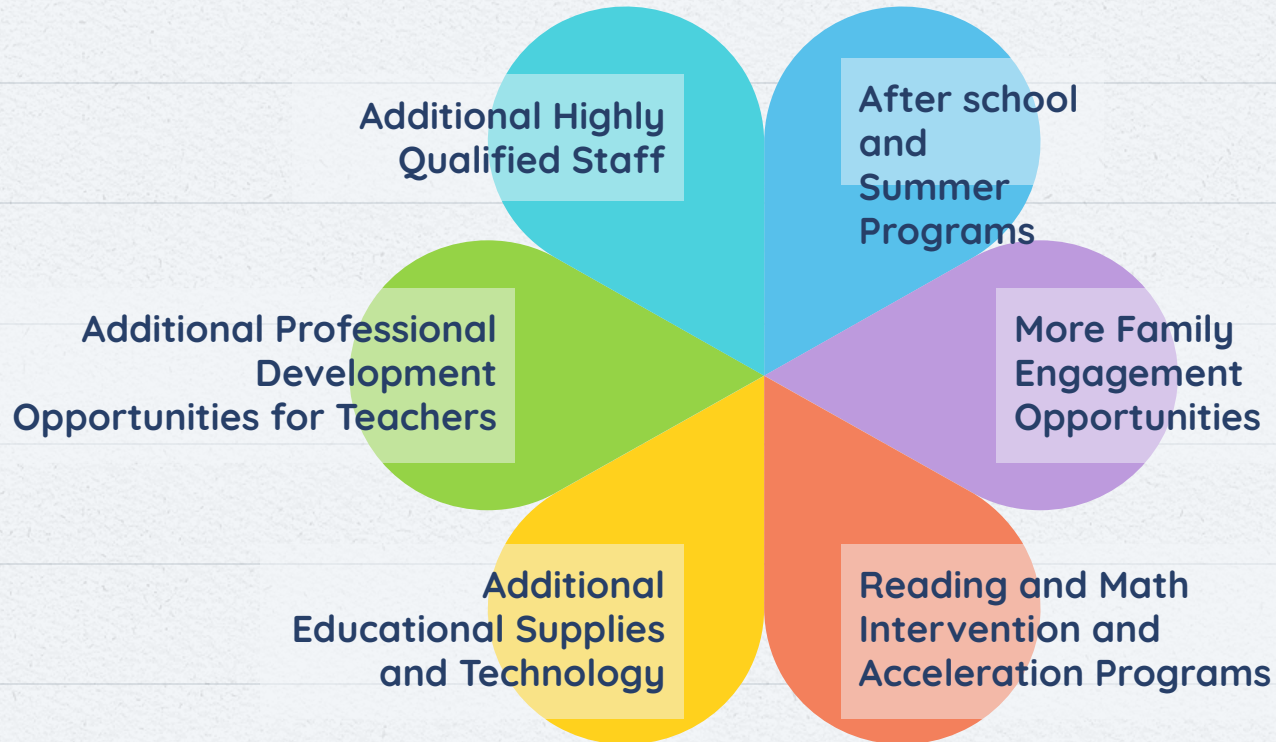

- ✗ Be informed about the qualifications of your child's teacher and paraprofessional.
- ✗ Be offered the opportunity to have input into the Title I plan and other school decisions.
- ✗ Be informed of the school's performance on federal and state accountability measures.

48 HOUR RULE

or the next school day.

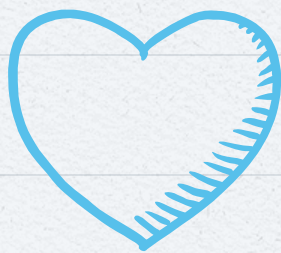
