

TITLE I BASICS

- * started in 1965 as a federal law called the Elementary and Secondary Education Act
- * provides supplementary financial assistance to districts and schools
- ensures fair, equal, significant opportunity for high-quality education for all children

Districts and schools with higher percentages of children from low-income families

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:


- Be informed about the qualifications of your child's teacher and paraprofessional.


