When does school start?

Tuesday, August 20th

What time does school start-end?

What supplies will my child need?

- Once you sign up for bus transportation in the front office you will receive a phone call for an approximate time of pick up & drop off. All K4 students are given a tag number and the parent (or designee) must have the matching tag at the bus stop.



Message from the Nurse

Welcome to our upcoming Otters! I am Nurse Pamela, and I am looking forward to a healthy and happy school year! As we prepare for a wonderful school year, there are a few things for you to know.

First, if your child will need to receive any medication (daily or as needed...such as an inhaler or epipen) during the school day, there are several papers that will need to be completed and signed by a physician BEFORE medications are able to be received in the health room. Students are NOT allowed to carry or bring medications to the health room. A parent or legal guardian will need to bring the medication and proper paperwork to the school. Second, all prescription and non-prescription medications must be brought to the school in their original container. We cannot receive medications in a zip lock bag or a bottle that does not have the proper prescription label. Nonprescription medications such as Benadryl and Tylenol need to be brought in a new unopened container. Thank you for your help in keeping our children healthy and safe!
