Submit to SC Future Minds website ([www.scfutureminds.org](http://www.scfutureminds.org)) or SC Future Minds FB page (<https://www.facebook.com/southcarolinafutureminds/>). Finalist videos will be chosen by members of the Grammy Award winning band "Hootie and the Blowfish." Public voting begins February 6, 2017 with winners being announce via Facebook (and email) on February 20, 2017.

Talent will be judged by SCFM based on its entertainment value and suitability for the South Carolina Teacher of the Year Celebration. The Celebration is attended by hundreds of education, business and governmental leaders from around South Carolina. SCFM has sole authority in selecting the winner(s). Employees and interns of SCFM and their immediate family members (spouse, parents, siblings and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible or are excluded. The video contest is subject to all applicable United States federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.

**AGREEMENT:** Participation in this contest constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to the "This School's Got Talent" official rules ("Official Rules") and SCFM's decisions, which are final and binding, in all matters related to this contest. Winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements of this document.

**WINNER NOTIFICATION:** Winner(s) will be notified via Facebook and email on or around February 20th. The winner(s) will have two (2) days after being notified via email to respond or forfeit the right to perform at The South Carolina Teacher of the Year Celebration. If a potential winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, fails to respond to the email notification within the required time period, is not in compliance with these official rules, or notification as a winner is returned as undeliverable, such potential winner forfeits the right to perform at the South Carolina Teacher of the Year Celebration. If a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, a runner-up, if any, may be chosen at SCFM's sole discretion.

Submission must be at least thirty (30) seconds in length and may not exceed five (5) minutes in length.
