Senior Exams

- May 25th Senior Exams 1st & 3rd Periods
- May 26th Senior Exams 2nd & 4th Periods
- May 27th Senior Make-up Exams & Senior Day–Last day of attendance for Seniors (Breakfast, class meeting, graduation practice, Check Out, exam make-up) This is a **required** event for ALL seniors.

ALL classes will have a senior exam or project.

Senior Dues

- These funds are used to support class projects, senior day (awards, plaques, flowers, and picnic food), illness and/or death among classmates, graduation ceremony (tickets, programs, flowers, facility rental, etc.).
- Senior Dues are now \$75.
- Payable online through MySchoolBucks.
- Senior Dues *do not* cover prom.

Senior Prom

- April 29 (*tentative*)
- ALL responsibilities (debts, fees, dues, books, etc...) must be cleared prior to being able to purchase prom tickets.

Graduation Supplies

- Cap & Gown—[purchase online](#).
- Minimum must purchase the cap, gown, and diploma cover.
- Current Price, as of 3/1, is \$72.95
 - Prices will continue to increase.
- No decorating of cap/gown
- Only EHS & GCSD approved cords, medallions, stolls, etc. may be worn on graduation day.

College & Career Ready (CCR)

CCR students will receive a medallion to wear at graduation. There are several indicators used by SC to qualify as CCR. Scoring a silver level or higher on WorkKeys is one of those indicators. Eastside will give WorkKeys career readiness test on April 5th

12th graders who are not CCR are scheduled to take WorkKeys. They will receive an email from Mrs. Calloway for their testing location on April 5th
