Student Driver Rules and Responsibilities

Parking Fines and Consequences- The following fines will be charged for violations of parking and driving regulations

- 1st Offense- written warning
- 2nd Offense- \$25.00 fine
- 3rd Offense- \$50.00 fine
- 4th Offense- Loss of driving privileges

- Parking permits must be hung from the rearview mirror facing out. Cars without permits can be ticketed and/or towed. **Parking permits may not be given or loaned to anyone, for any reason.**
- **You must park in your assigned spot.** You are not allowed to park anywhere else on the premises during school hours. Parking in light pole outlines, handicapped spots (without a valid handicapped tag), and diagonally lined spaces next to handicapped spots is strictly prohibited. Vehicles parked in prohibited areas will be ticketed and/or towed.
- Once you enter the parking lot, school rules apply. Students may not loiter in the parking lot before or after school.
- All parking lots are considered off-limits during the school day. Permission to return to the parking lot for any reason during the school day must be obtained from an administrator.
- Lost, misplaced, destroyed, or defaced parking permits must be replaced immediately at a cost of \$50. If you change vehicles during the year, you must inform the office.
- Students who violate these rules, drive recklessly, or in excess of 10 mph in the parking lot may have their parking privileges revoked.
- Lock your vehicle. The school is not responsible for theft and/or vandalism to vehicles.

- Note:
- ✓ Any vehicle on school grounds is subject to search by administration and/or the School Resource Officer at any time. You are responsible for items found in your vehicle.
 - ✓ If a permit is lost or stolen, a new permit must be purchased at full price. A new application will have to be completed and submitted.
 - ✓ If someone is parked in your space, please notify Mr. Drango in the parking lot or the front office.
 - ✓ **Eastside High School reserves the right to have any vehicle towed, at the owner's expense, if it is in violation of any parking regulation.**
