Our student population is made up of students from Carolina High, Travelers Rest High, Wadehampton High, and Berea High. The programs and courses offered at Enoree include Automotive Collision Repair, Automotive Technology, Building Construction, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Firefighting, Law Enforcement, Graphic Communications, Production Engineering, Mechatronics, and Welding Technology. Additionally, Enoree Career Center offers a Career Academy program for ninth-grade students who want to learn more about career options and learning opportunities at the career centers.

SIC GOALS

Increase student access to meaningful Work-Based Learning (WBL) experiences aligned to their program of study.

Actions Taken:

- Collaborated with instructors to identify and develop both in-house and external WBL opportunities across all programs.
- Strengthened partnerships with local businesses and industry representatives to expand placement options for students.
- Established clear expectations and tracking systems for WBL participation, including time logs and project-based experiences.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Other highlights and achievements of our programs this year include the following:

- Our enrollment continues to grow, with 458 student enrolled in our programs for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Enoree's Career Academy served 121 students from our feeder high schools and has created a feeder pattern into our two-year programs of over 50%. This is a growth from 30% the prior year.
- Enoree and Greenville Technical College are working together to offer dual credit opportunities in Culinary Arts and Mechatronics for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Enoree students have a goal of earning at least 3 industry certifications, at the time of this report final numbers are not available.
- Kristina Zagel was named Enoree's Student of the Year and will be recognized at the Salute to Education Banquet in late May.
- 178 students are program Completers, and the seniors will be recognized at their high school graduation ceremony and a Completer Awards Ceremony on May 4 at Trailblazer Park.
- Bill Twaler, Culinary Arts Instructor, is the 2026-2027 Enoree Teacher of the Year and Top 10 Finalist for GCS Teacher of the Year.
