

Students who are enrolled in home school, charter school, or private school programs who would be zoned for Berea High, Carolina High, Travelers Rest High, or Wade Hampton High may apply for a class at Enoree Career Center. Limited seats are available in each program. Please note that Enoree Career Center must adhere to [district policy JBC](#) which states:

A home-schooled or private-school student may participate in district classes if the student can show reasonable need and interest for the class, the appropriate district-level administrator approves the student's participation prior to entry, and the student pays any additional cost as calculated by the district. The following rules shall apply to any participation in classes by students not enrolled in the district's schools:

- The student's participation shall be subject to all policies, rules, regulations, and standards of the district relating to the participation and any additional policies, rules, regulations, and standards established by the district for the participation.*
- The participation shall be at the district school that the student would otherwise attend.*
- The participation shall not preclude the participation of any student enrolled in the school.*
- If the student's participation would result in any cost to the district or school, the student may participate so long as the cost is paid.*
