

# Law Enforcement

## Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security Cluster



The students will learn communication skills, impact of the US Constitution, SC law, importance of ethics, values, and principles, use of force, physical and emotional health impact, patrol procedures, tactics, traffic stops, crime scene investigation, substance abuse issues, court procedures, and terrorism issues. Students will also be required to participate in frequent physical training.

### Program Duration & Grade Level

Law Enforcement is a two (2) year program.

Grade levels: 10, 11, 12    Level 1: AM session    Level 2: PM session

Upon Completion of this two year program, students could receive the following certifications:

- Dispatch (IAED and Greenville County Sheriff's Office)
- OSHA-10 Safety Training
- First Aid/CPR
- National Incident Management System through FEMA
