


LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE (F2F) HIGH SCHOO

What Parents Should Know

Three color groups (75% of high school student population) attend each day. The remaining color group will be eLearning. Due to classroom size and the number of students in each class, we are only able to return 75% of students at one time and still maintain social distancing protocols. Some classes may be moved to larger spaces (auditorium or commons area) to accommodate larger class sizes.

High school students will attend in-person school three days a week by color group. In addition to three in-person days each week, high school students will attend three out of every four Fridays. Their attendance days will be based on color group. Specific Friday attendance dates for each color group are listed on this chart.

Students will participate in eLearning whenever they are not in person.

If students are unable to attend in-person school due to weather or other unexpected circumstances, they will participate in eLearning. Students will return to in-person school on their assigned color group day (no changes in schedule).

Plexiglass dividers will be installed in most high school classrooms. In September DHEC expanded the definition of social distancing to include masked individuals separated by 3 feet of distance and appropriately-sized plexiglass as equivalent to 6 feet of social distancing. Students will clean their plexiglass pods at the beginning and end of each class period using alcohol wipes.

Students will be required to wear masks when 6 feet of social distancing is not possible and when sitting in plexiglass clusters.

This schedule does **not** impact high school students in the Virtual Program.
