We are kindness leaders, relationship builders, and successful learners. We are Greenbrier, the school of kindness.

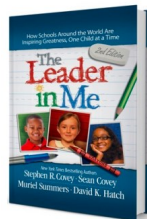
#### Our Vision

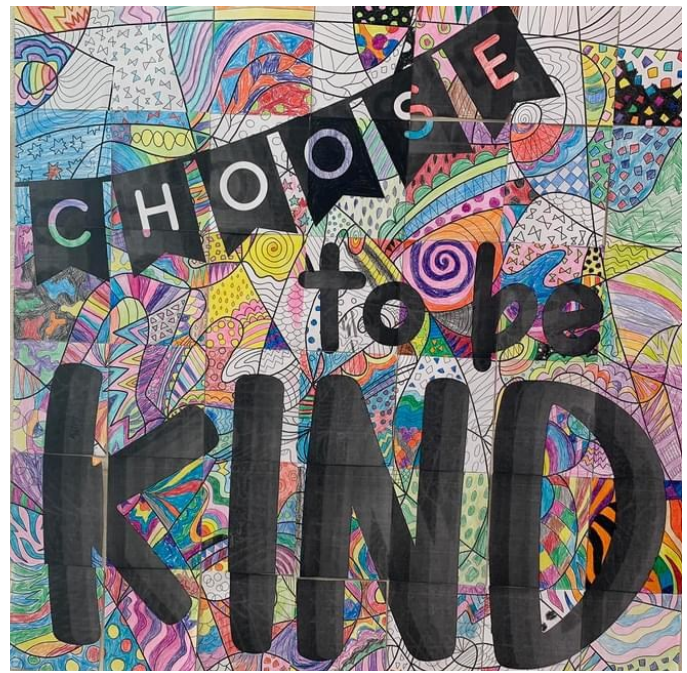
